Primary Responsibilities:

### **Camp Marshall**

**Facility:** The care and operation is one primary area that I maintained responsibility for through April of 2007. During this time, I continued working as the site manager. This involved two primary focuses of caring for the facility and serving rental groups.

**Placement of a new site manager:** In April of 2007 Julie Sisler was hired by the diocese of Montana to serve as the new site manager for Camp Marshall. This was done in conjunction of goals set by the Camp Committee in 2005 to free up the Camp Director to have more time to develop marketing for the camp with the goal of eventually developing a capital campaign for Camp Marshall.

**Camp Marshall Ambassadors:** In 2007, each parish in the diocese was asked to have a Camp Marshall Ambassador serve as a primary force in each congregation for marketing Camp Marshall fund raising and marketing efforts. This proved to be very successful. Evidence of this can be found in several areas. Financial, we raised over 30,000.00, which are approximately three times our normal fund raising efforts. Volunteers: In 2007 we had forty two volunteers help us with the summer program. This was the most volunteers we have had in well over ten years. Enrollments: Enrollments jumped about 9% over the previous year.

**Summer Program** – As director of the summer program my responsibility includes the preparation for the summer season, which include, fund raising, advertising, hiring office administration and visiting parishes that request a visit to share about the summer program. Once the summer begins, I remain on site for the duration, then, went on the road to serve as site director for the two day camp sites that operated in 2007.

**A special thank you to our volunteers and financial supporters:** It would be an understatement to express how impossible any of these ministries would be to accomplish without the time, talent and physical support of so many persons from around the diocese. Every thing you do has mad a difference for our young people. Thank you.

### **Youth Ministries.**

This part of my job saw a significant change in 2007 as I moved to Helena with the specific purpose of making more time to work with parishes to develop ministries for Youth and Young adult programs. To initiate this effort I conducted a survey of parishes around the state to asses where parishes are in the development of these ministries.

As a result of this survey, I spent a great deal of time working on the development of policies that are meant to work with “Safeguarding God’s Children” which will serve as a baseline for

leadership development in all youth programming. The first Draft of the new Policy was completed in September of 2007. This new policy will be put into practice in 2009.

**Province Six Work:**

In 2007 I have been participating in the Province Six Faith Formation Network. Province six is mad of the following diocese; Colorado, Iowa, Minnesota, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, Wyoming. The primary purpose of our time together is to network persons who have responsibilities with children and youth ministries. In 2007, the group took on the challenge of creating a leadership training event for persons connected with these ministries. This event will occur the first weekend in May of 2008 and will be hosted by the Diocese of Colorado.
